1. Call to Order

2. Roll Call

4. Approve Past Minutes

James Hoffman moved to approve past meeting minutes of Feb 28, 2021. Fred Hofer seconded the motion. Vote: Yes - 8, No - 0. Unanimous. Motion carried.

5. President's Report: Doug Schabell

- a. Update on Puna Strong Grant Submission: Small grant proposal of \$20,000 submitted on March 26, 2021 to The County for a feasibility study for a larger USDA commercial kitchen grant. The non-profit Recycle Hawaii fiscally-sponsored our grant submission as HACA itself is ineligible to submit for grant as a 501(c)4. Special thanks to Shannon Matson, board member of Recycle Hawaii, who helped with this endeavor. We will know the status of the grant in the coming weeks.
- b. Ask to Remove Lopaka Milliora as a HACA Bank Signatory: With this ask, there will still be three board members with administrative privileges for HACA bank accounts.

Alex Shade moved to approve the motion. a Hofer seconded the motion.

Vote: Yes - 8, No - 0. Unanimous. Motion carried.

6. Vice Presidents' Report: Lopaka Milliora

a. Not present.

7. Secretary's Report: Lisa Bevier-Sakimura

a. Update on Road Improvement District: In April 2020, a survey was sent to the Hawaiian Acres Community indicating over 80% of the 700 respondents were positive about the Improvement District. On March 18, 2021, Puna Councilman Matt Kaneali'i-Kleinfelder joined HACA and HARC for a joint executive session to discuss the Road Improvement District. Boards discussed and unanimously voted to request Matt to bring resolution to the County to conduct a Feasibility Study (FS) for improving our roads. The FS requires the County to analyze the economic, technical, legal, and scheduling considerations to pave roads up to County code and provide a financial analysis of the cost. Following the vote, Doug Schabell and Lisa Bevier-Sakimura drafted a joint letter for Matt to take to The County to move forward on the FS. Please see March 18, 2021 Meeting Minutes for exact details on the FS process.

8. Treasurer's Report: James Kiley

- a. Reviewing Best Practices of HOAs: James will look into putting together a book of procedures and policies for future board bodies.

9. Old Business

a. Real Estate Sales Update (Jim Hoffman): HACA has 10 more days (out of 30 total) to sell two lots on the corner of B and 5, otherwise project transfers to a real estate agent on April 18, 2021, which estimates a \$1,000 commision per lot. A potential realtor has been identified but not officially confirmed.

- a. *Hawaiian Language Classes (Fred Hofer)*: Having technical issues with the HACA TV to conduct the classes, but Fred will ask tech-savvy community members to assist in resolving the issue.
- b. HACA TV Remote May Be Missing (Alex Shade): Doug Schabell to follow up on the search.
- c. Community Park Benches (Jim Hoffman): HACA is looking for volunteer help to put together benches for the playground. Lopaka Milliora is donating cinder blocks but other materials (wood and cement) are not yet purchased until a handy volunteer is identified.
