Weekly update for May 22nd, 2023

Aloha,

All paperwork is complete and being processed by the Hawaii County Building Dept., the first step of the rebuilding project. Our general contractor will begin dismantling the old building as soon as it is approved. We are working with our Architect and will publish drawings for your review when available.

Many residents want to know when the HACA-sponsored Hawaiian Acres Community Market will open again. Our board is looking to reopen our market as soon as the building demolition is complete. We will need to coordinate with our contractor, so the event does not interfere with or delay the building process.

Friday afternoon and early evening have been the usual time frame. However, we may need to be flexible in our scheduled times. For the time being, it may be necessary to change to a Saturday or Sunday.

We also need volunteers to assist in directing visitors to park in designated areas. There is no parking on the road right of way. With your volunteer help, we can open our market again.
