Welcome to the Hawaiian Acres Market, we are happy to provide a venue for you to sell your products and to connect with your community! The Hawaiian Acres Community Association was granted a Special Use Permit to host a weekly community market.

We are asking all vendors to please read through the following market guidelines and sign the attached Vendor Acknowledgement Form.

1. Vendors may arrive between 1:30-2pm to set up. Please unload your vehicle and park in the designated vendor parking area located in the parking lot between the portable toilet and firehouse. We want to ensure front spaces are available for market patrons as much as possible.
2. Vendors who arrive after 2pm will need to use the four stalls designated as "loading/unloading only" (10 minute parking). At the close of the market, please pack up as much as possible before bringing your vehicle into the loading zone.
3. There is no vendor fee required at this time to vend at the market. However, we do ask for a donation to be given (\$5 or more) to help pay for the portable toilet.
4. Vendor spaces are on a first come first serve basis and all vendors are required to vend within the market perimeters to ensure traffic safety. No vendors will be allowed to vend outside the market perimeters.
5. All food vendors are required to have a current food handling certificate. The Free class is available online with the County of Hawaii. A variety of days/time can be found at this site :

6. Vendors selling homemade food products that are not potentially hazardous are required to label their products notifying customers that their goods are "baked in a home kitchen and not routinely inspected by the health dept."
7. Vendors selling food are responsible for all required permits/licenses needed to operate their booth.
8. Hawaiian Acres Community Association & Hawaiian Acres Food Hub are not liable for any losses or damages to your business or booth operations during the weekly market.
9. Vendors are responsible for their children at the market at all times.
10. Yelling, fighting, bullying and harassment towards vendors and patrons will not be tolerated.
